



Module 1: Divine Providence vs. Worldly Care

Opening Prayer

O God, eternal Father, we consecrate this lecture to You.

Intentio (Aim Statement)

The aim of this lecture is to establish that God governs all things through Divine Providence, so that the soul may reject worldly anxiety and live in trusting surrender to His wise and fatherly care.

Lectio (Core Axiom)

Divine Providence means that God, having created the world, continually sustains and governs all things through His wise and fatherly guidance. The world is not ruled by chance, blind forces, or impersonal fate, but by the providential governance of a Father who orders all things toward their proper end. Nothing occurs outside His knowledge or permission, for all creation unfolds according to His eternal plan.

As Sacred Scripture declares, "The LORD has made everything for its purpose" (Proverbs 16:4). And as Thomas Aquinas teaches in the *Summa Theologiae*, Providence is "the plan existing in the mind of God by which all things are directed to their proper end" (ST I, q.22).

God positively wills all that is good and permits evil only insofar as He draws from it a greater good while preserving the real freedom of His creatures. Therefore every event in human life may become an occasion of sanctification for the Christian who responds with faith, virtue, and trust. Under Divine Providence the faithful are called to abandon disordered worldly anxiety and to live in trusting peace beneath the fatherly governance of God.

God's Providential Governance

Establishing God's wise and fatherly direction over all creation, counteracting notions of chance or blind force.

Scriptural & Thomistic Foundations

grounding this doctrine in the authoritative teachings of Sacred Scripture and St. Thomas Aquinas.

Providence, Freedom & Evil

Examining how Divine Providence encompasses human freedom and the permissive allowance of evil without diminishing God's goodness.

From Anxiety to Peace

Learning how this transformative truth replaces worldly anxiety with an abiding trust and peace in God's loving rule.



Expositio (Explanation)

This section unpacks the profound truth of Divine Providence through four essential movements, revealing God's continuous, wise, and loving governance over all creation.

Fatherly Governance, Not Chance

God continually sustains and directs all things by wise and loving fatherly Providence, not by blind force or randomness.

Scriptural & Scholastic Grounding

Sacred Scripture and St. Thomas Aquinas affirm God's eternal plan, ordering all things to their proper end.

Providence, Freedom & Evil

God actively wills good and permits evil through human freedom, sovereignly directing all toward a greater good.

From Anxiety to Trusting Peace

Recognizing God's fatherly Providence transforms worldly care into confident trust and spiritual peace.
